Description

This project is situated in southwest Bryan near Gabbard Road. The project consists of the removal and replacement of the existing storm sewer system which extends from the cul-de-sac of Wilderness Circle to an unnamed tributary of Turkey Creek. This project includes the reconstruction of the inlet, laying of approximately 200 linear feet of storm sewer and erosion control at the discharge into the unnamed tributary.

Justification

This section of storm sewer is undersized and lays relatively shallow below the existing ground surface. This site requires repeated seasonal maintenance be performed to allow function of the storm sewer system.
