Description

Construction of raised medians at the intersection 29th Street and Villa Maria Rd, The medians would extend from Osler Blvd North along Villa Maria to 500 feet beyond 29th St, and from Joseph Dr. East along 29th Street to Dee Lee St.

Justification

Partially associated with Blinn College, there is a high volume of traffic at this intersection with a large number of business drives. Many unsafe maneuvers occur at this intersection; most notable are turning movements across 3 lanes of traffic which cause delays in normal traffic flow. Additionally zero to limited sight distances create unsafe conditions for left turn movements from the multiple business driveways in the area. Crash diagrams indicate that many of the recorded accidents at this intersection would be preventable by installation of raised medians to limit left hand turn movements. This project was submitted for consideration in the 2016 Highway Safety Improvement Program.
