RESOLUTION NO. 3977

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYAN, TEXAS APPROVING AMENDMENT #1 TO THE FIVE YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEARS 2022 THROUGH 2026;

WHEREAS, the City of Bryan has an annual process for reviewing the Five Year Capital Improvement Program that includes approval of a new Five Year program every two years, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bryan approved the Fiscal Year 2022 thru 2026 CIP Program on August 10, 2021, and

WHEREAS, changes are proposed to the slate of projects for Fiscal Years 2022 and 2026, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bryan intends to issue new debt to fund the projects listed in Fiscal Year 2022, and

WHEREAS, the City Council is giving direction to staff about the projects planned in the Fiscal Years 2022-2026 to provide consistent direction on projects that may span more than one year, and

WHEREAS, the approval of a Five Year Capital Improvement Program allows staff to plan for right of way acquisition and design that may take time prior to the construction of specific Capital Improvements,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYAN, TEXAS:

1.

That the City Council hereby adopts and approves the recitals and findings set forth in the preamble above.

2.

That the City Council hereby passes this resolution approving the modifications to FY2022 and FY2024 projects as shown on the revised Exhibit B in Amendment #1.

3.

That the City Council agrees to direct staff to take steps to issue the needed debt in Fiscal Year 2022 to fund the planned projects.

4.

It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was open to the public as required by law and that notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.
