Description

The project is a roadway between Sam Rayburn Drive and the Sam Rayburn Middle School. This roadway will be crossing a FEMA regulated Floodplain. A waterline would be installed that would provide added looping of the distribution system in the area. This project would likely be associated with a development project.

Justification

It also provides an alternative route to the Middle School. There currently exist a situation where cars back up onto the SH 6 access road while picking up and dropping off children. This road would connect Sam Rayburn Drive to the middle school and will help reduce congestion around the school. Currently the only access to and from the Middle School is along the oneway frontage road. The waterline to be constructed with the road has been identified as needed for increased pressure and redundancy.
